

California Art Club Award Winners

The California Art Club recently held its 98th Annual Gold Medal Juried Exhibition at the Pasadena Museum of California Art. One hundred eighty-six artists were accepted for inclusion in the show, and two artists were selected for Gold Medal honors: Daniel W. Pinkham and Aldo Casanova. Pinkham, a renowned, environmentally oriented plein air painter, was awarded the Gold Medal for Best Painting for Enlightened. Casanova, an 80-year-old sculptor and art professor, was awarded the Gold Medal for Best Sculpture for Sky Emblem. Also receiving awards at the show were Dennis Doheny, who won the Edgar Payne Award for Best Landscape Painting for Opalescence, and Jove Wang, who received the Guy Rose Award for Best Multi-Figurative Composition, for A Day at Silk Road.
