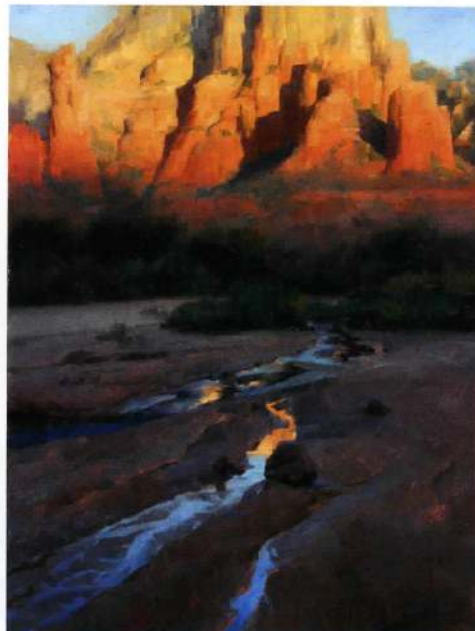

Artists also earn \$1,000 cash for First Place in the bi-monthly contests. Second Place, Third Place, and category winners in each bimonthly contest will be published in PleinAir Magazine.

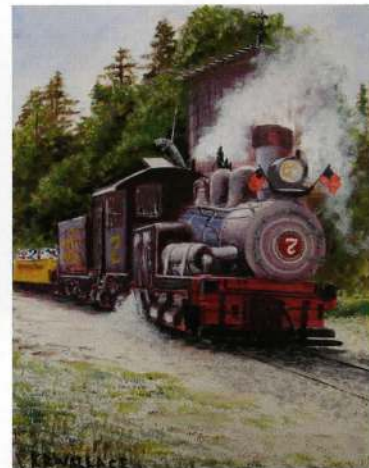

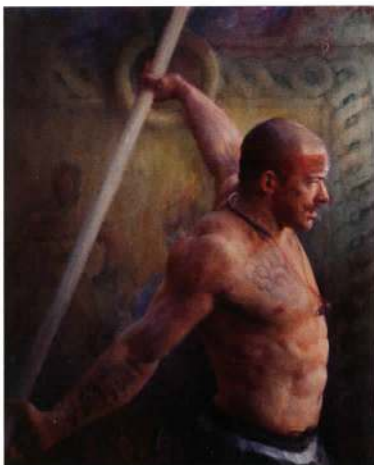
